- 2 **SG2 1840 1d. Black Pl.1b (QG). Magenta Maltese Cross.** Good to wide margined example this this distinctive and rare coloured MC. *Spec. AS5vd – Cat. £2250.* **£650**
- 3 **SG2 1840 1d. Black pl.2 (CH).** Clear to wide margined example cancelled by a lovely strike of the red MC... very pretty. **£395**
